PRAYOG - Building the Future

Trains, Deploys and Felicitates, Volunteers for Ganeshotsav (biggest festival in Maharashtra, wherein idol of Lord Ganesh is worshipped for 10 days then immersed with a huge processions with pomp and gaietie) and Navratraotsav (a 9 days and nights festival of Garba and Dandiya dance as offering to Goddess Durga, Lakhs of people come together for these 9 nights).

Ganesh Chaturthi is a very auspicious event for Mumbaities and people from all the facets of life participate in it. Practically every 5th house in Mumbai celebrates Ganesh Chaturthi and hence on the day of Ananth Chaturdashi (11th day) people in lakhs throng to the nearby lakes or go to the beaches to immerse the idol of Lord Ganesh.

Project Prayog also provides well equipped Ambulances, Doctors and Medical Staff on the day of Ganpati Visarjan (Anant Chaturthi). A Project which Trains, Deploys and Felicitates, National Social Service (NSS), National Cadet Corps (NCC), Maharashtra Cader Corps (MCC), Road Safety Patrol (RSP), Scout, Guides, Eagle Brigade and Civil Defense Volunteers for Ganeshotsav and Navratraotsav Bandobast (arrangements).

Prayog is a three phase programme. The orientation session is the first phase where the students are trained on how to manage the crowd during the Ganeshotsav Bandobast. The second phase involves the actual deployment of the students followed by the third and last phase of recognizing the students efforts by organizing a Award Programme.

Since last 8 years, in all 16000 volunteers have received Prayog certificate for assisting in the Bandobast (arrangements).

This Project has successfully completed 8 years of service in 85 Police Stations of Mumbai. This project has changed and evolved for the better. Its advent was in the jurisdiction of one police station and now it encapsulates Mumbai City. It began with one watch tower and a single ambulance, now the project has many watch towers and a fleet of ambulances and disaster management vehicles connected via wireless communication network.


