Teachers to understand student's mind better

On 14th November 2014, the first batch of 80 teachers of Shree Sanatan Dharma High School, GTB Nagar underwent a half day skill enhancement program conducted jointly by Gourav Sarkar, CEO and Gautam S.T. Children's day was an apt occasion to launch this program for the teachers to enable them to understand a child's mind better.

Parable of Success - a teacher's skill enhancement program on Self Belief, Innovation and Understanding the young mindsinfuses the life skills in to the children missed due to non supportive parents and over burdened teachers. This initiative aims to distinguish between the reality and interpretations of the reality to enable teachers handle the innocent students more effectively.

A pre and post session assessment was conducted and the results were startling! All teachers wanted a repetition of this interactive session every 2 months. "An attitudinal change towards positivity and self motivation" was the high point of the session, said majority of the teachers.

Mrs. Veena Nandrajog, Principal of Shree Sanatan Dharma High School said it was a privilege that this movement has been initiated from her institution and she insists all the schools to voluntarily conduct this skill enhancement program for all of their teachers.

"We promise to conduct this self financed program to reach 2000 teachers in this academic year", said Social Entrepreneur and Advisor - Sundeep Sharma who is also the patron of the Corporate Social Responsibility. He added – "As there is Continuous Medical Education (CME) for doctors, we have devised a Continuous Teacher's Education (CTE) for a better India.

#### School adoption

Adopted a 120 students Secondary School in Adivasi area (adivasis are tribals living in jungles or remote areas) in district of Thane, Maharashtra. Resource mobilization for the school building, borewell for water and ambulance for medical emergencies and a Computer Centre are some of the activities co-ordinated and established. The Computer Centre was setup on 9th July 2006. This is a first centre of its kind in a radius of 25 kms. Hardware for this Computer Lab was donated by the HDFC Bank.

Sanganika (Computerization) -

Today, is the era of computers it has become a common subject in every school, but schools that cannot afford computers education deprive their students from it, realizing this, a project was conceived.

Setting of Computer Labs and impart computer education to the students in the schools run by the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC), each school received 2 PCs and 1 Printer. This is an ongoing project. The computer was donated by ICICI Bank. This project was in co-ordination with M/s. learn@home.com, who trained two progressive teachers from each school. This is a perfect example of corporate responsibility cell teaming up with an NGO to successfully launch and execute an educational project.
